B. "S" stands for "STRENGTH".

"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing." John 15:5-6

C. "A" stands for "ACCEPTANCE".

D. "N" stands for "NEW LIFE".

So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace". Romans 8:5-7
